## 1. What Are Cookies?

Cookies are small text files that are placed on your computer, smartphone, or tablet when you visit a website. They help the website work properly, remember your preferences, and give us information on how people use our site so we can improve it.

## 2. How We Use Cookies

We use cookies on The Restore Project CIC website for:

- **Essential cookies:** These are needed to make the site work (e.g. security, log-in functions, filling in forms).
- **Analytics cookies:** To help us understand how visitors use our site (e.g. which pages are most popular) so we can improve our content and services.
- **Preference cookies:** To remember your choices, such as text size or accessibility settings.

We do **not** use cookies for advertising, tracking across other websites, or selling data.

## 3. Third-Party Cookies

Sometimes we use trusted third-party services that set cookies, such as:

- **Google Analytics (to understand website usage and traffic).**
- **Embedded content (such as maps, videos, or donation forms) which may set their own cookies.**

## 4. Managing Cookies

You can control and delete cookies through your browser settings:

- **You can delete all cookies already stored on your device.**
- **You can block cookies from being placed in future.**

However, if you block essential cookies, some parts of our website may not work properly.
