1. What Are Cookies?

Cookies are small text files that are placed on your computer, smartphone, or tablet when you visit a website. They help the website work properly, remember your preferences, and give us information on how people use our site so we can improve it.

2. How We Use Cookies

We use cookies on The Restore Project CIC website for:

- Essential cookies: These are needed to make the site work (e.g. security, log-in functions, filling in forms).
- Analytics cookies: To help us understand how visitors use our site (e.g. which
 pages are most popular) so we can improve our content and services.
- Preference cookies: To remember your choices, such as text size or accessibility settings.

We do **not** use cookies for advertising, tracking across other websites, or selling data.

3. Third-Party Cookies

Sometimes we use trusted third-party services that set cookies, such as:

- Google Analytics (to understand website usage and traffic).
- Embedded content (such as maps, videos, or donation forms) which may set their own cookies.

4. Managing Cookies

You can control and delete cookies through your browser settings:

- You can delete all cookies already stored on your device.
- You can block cookies from being placed in future.

However, if you block essential cookies, some parts of our website may not work properly.
